NMC-BASIS supported this week StratMos DP4 project "Secured trade lanes in the North Continent-Russia Corridor" in Saint Petersburg. The project is coordinated by Frank Knoors from Sequuyah. There were arranged 2 meetings, one with the President Administration for North-West Russia and the second with the First Container Terminal, used by Mediterranean Shipping Company as a hub to the Russian market.

Also North-West customs authorities were represented at this meeting. After a brief excursion in the terminal area, there were reports and discussions at the Terminal Directors office. The DP4 project is about taking containers into the Russian marked with CSD (Circuit Switched Data) and preliminary electronic customs declaration, which means that the handling of the containers would go smoother and faster into the port and out from the port to the hinterland. The terminal is ready to provide this handling of the containers, but due to the Russian Federation Customs law, no CSD devices could be handled before they get a technical description of the devices.
