
With half of Norway's population within a 150-kilometer radius, Drammen enjoys a central location in the most densely populated region of the country.


After several years of extensive construction and development, the Port of Drammen is one of the most modern ports in Norway and we are now fully realizing our vision of being a multi modal transport centre.














FACTS


- Weekly ro-ro service to Bremerhaven, Zeebrugge, Southampton and Tyne
- Weekly lo-lo service to Rotterdam, Immingham, Helsinki, Tallinn, Klaipeda and Esbjerg
- Norway's leading port for import and handling of new cars
- Direct access by rail to the car terminal and the container terminal
- Direct access to the E-18, E-23 and E-134 motorways
- Cranes: Port of Drammen has 4 quayside cranes, 23 to 100 tons
- Storage: Port of Drammen owns a total of 46.000 sq.m of warehouses
- 3 million tons of cargo are handled by the port each year
- Total quay length is 1.985 meters, depth up to 11 meters, including 2 ro-ro berths
- Well trained and dedicated staff
