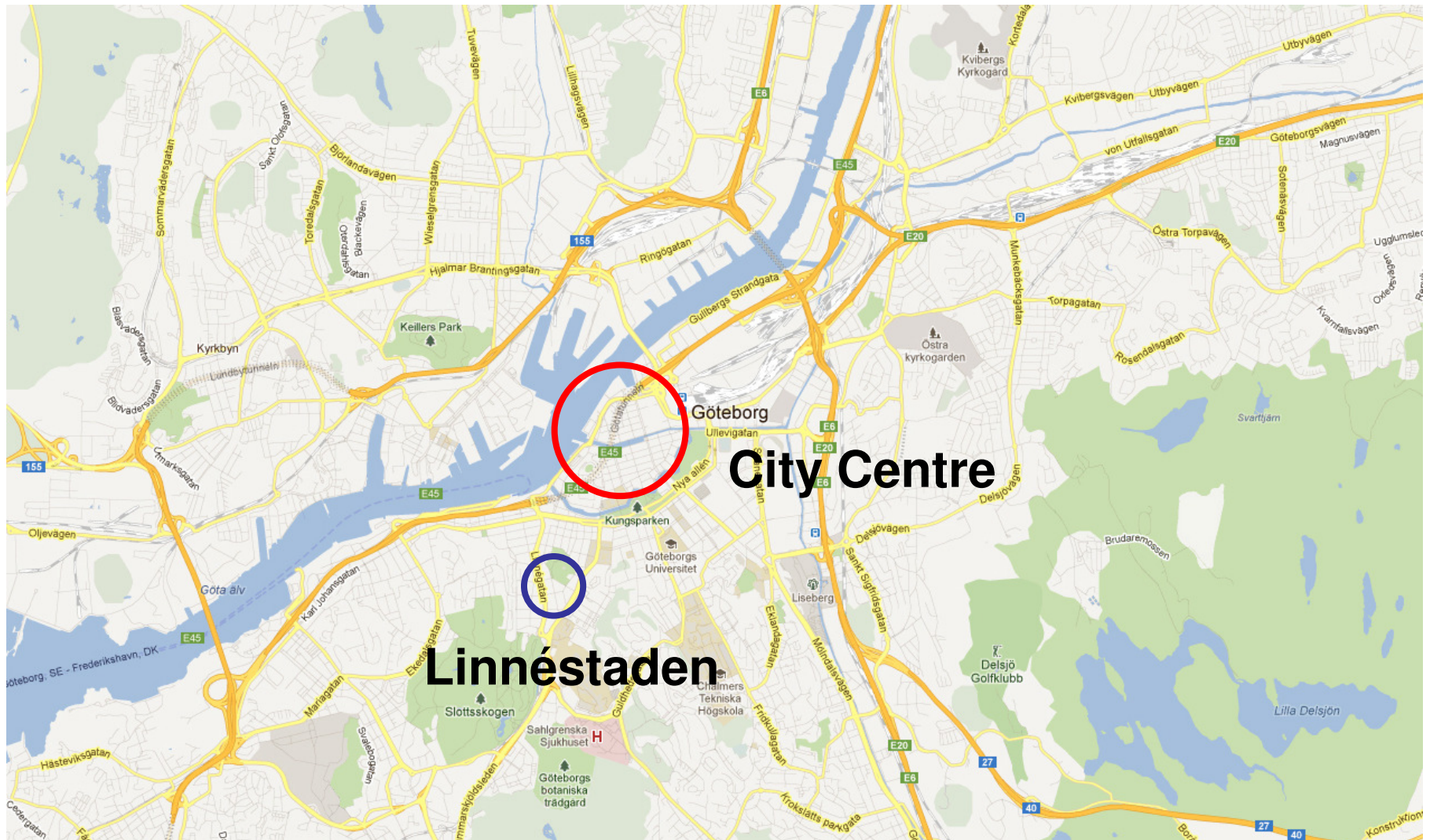

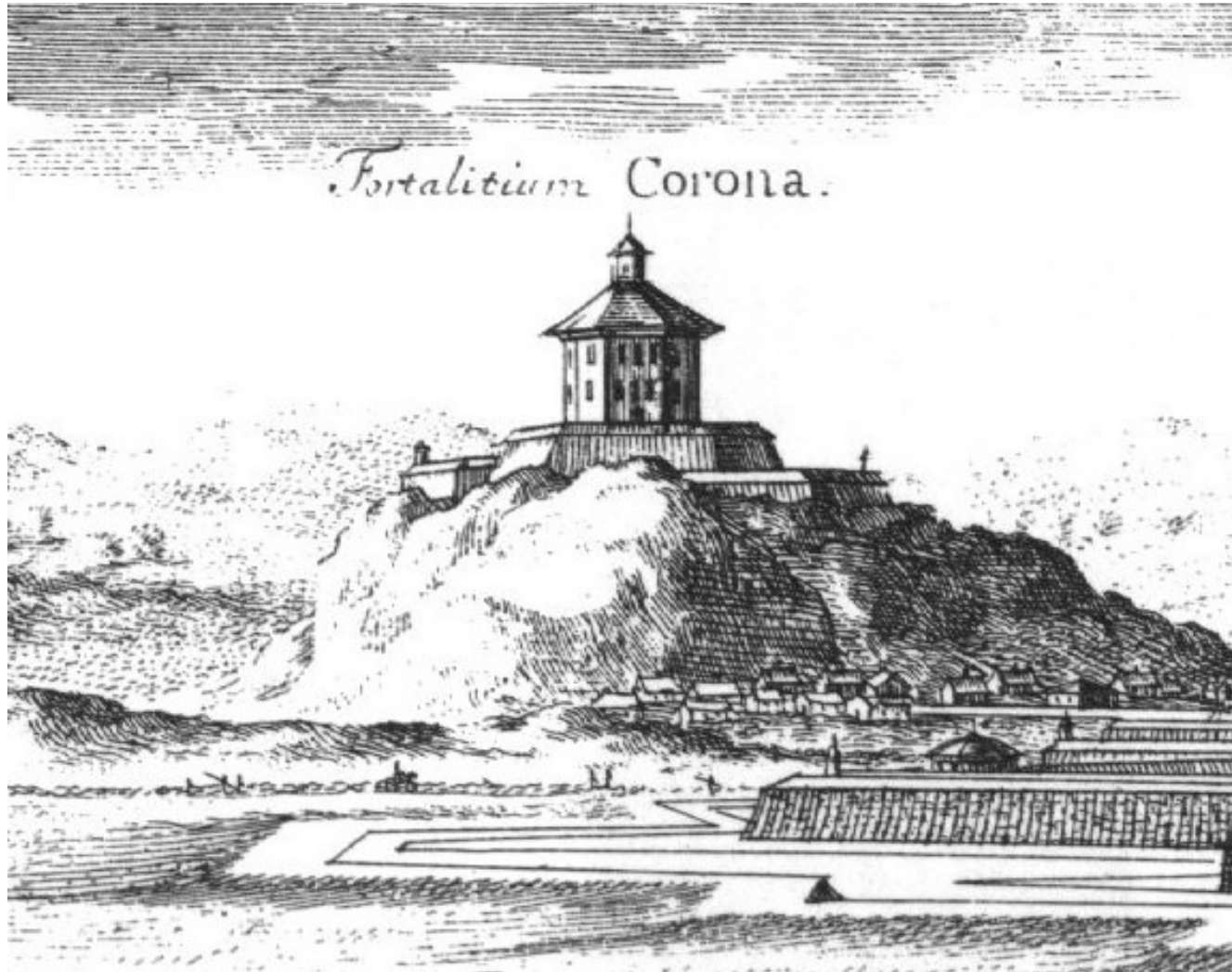

Winter/Spring of 2013

- 1st phase of construction works completed
- Strategy for the implementation of the second phase

Spring/Autumn of 2013

- 2nd phase of construction works are due to commence
