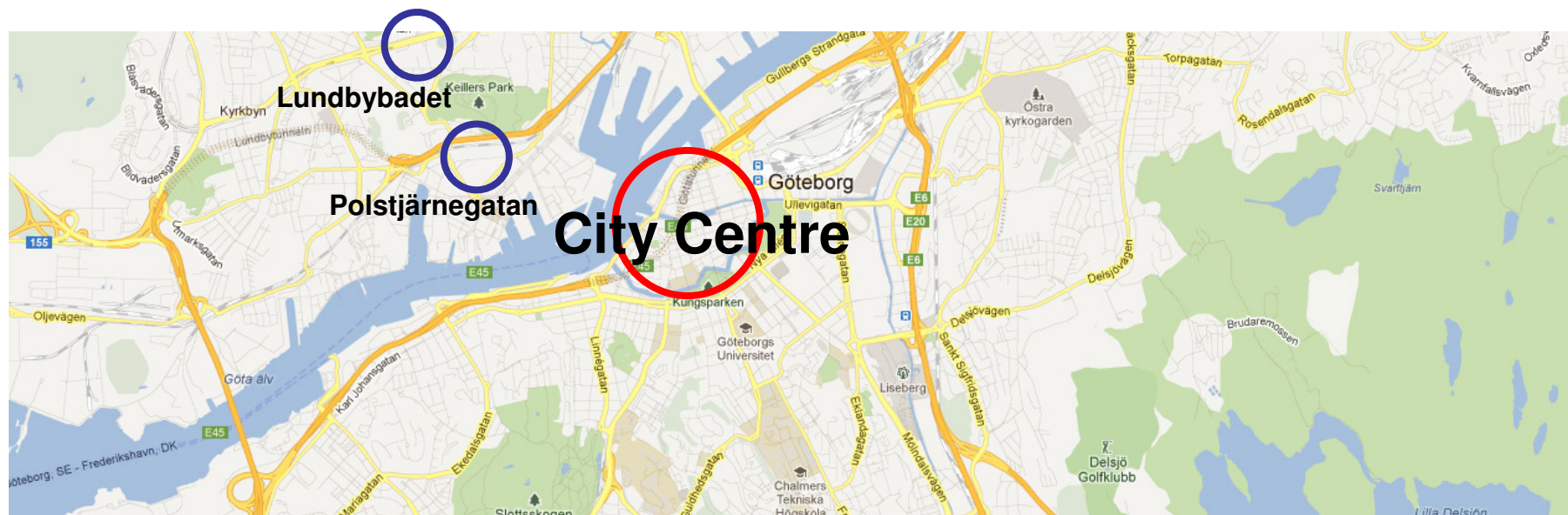

**Aim:** Locate a site for the activities to take place

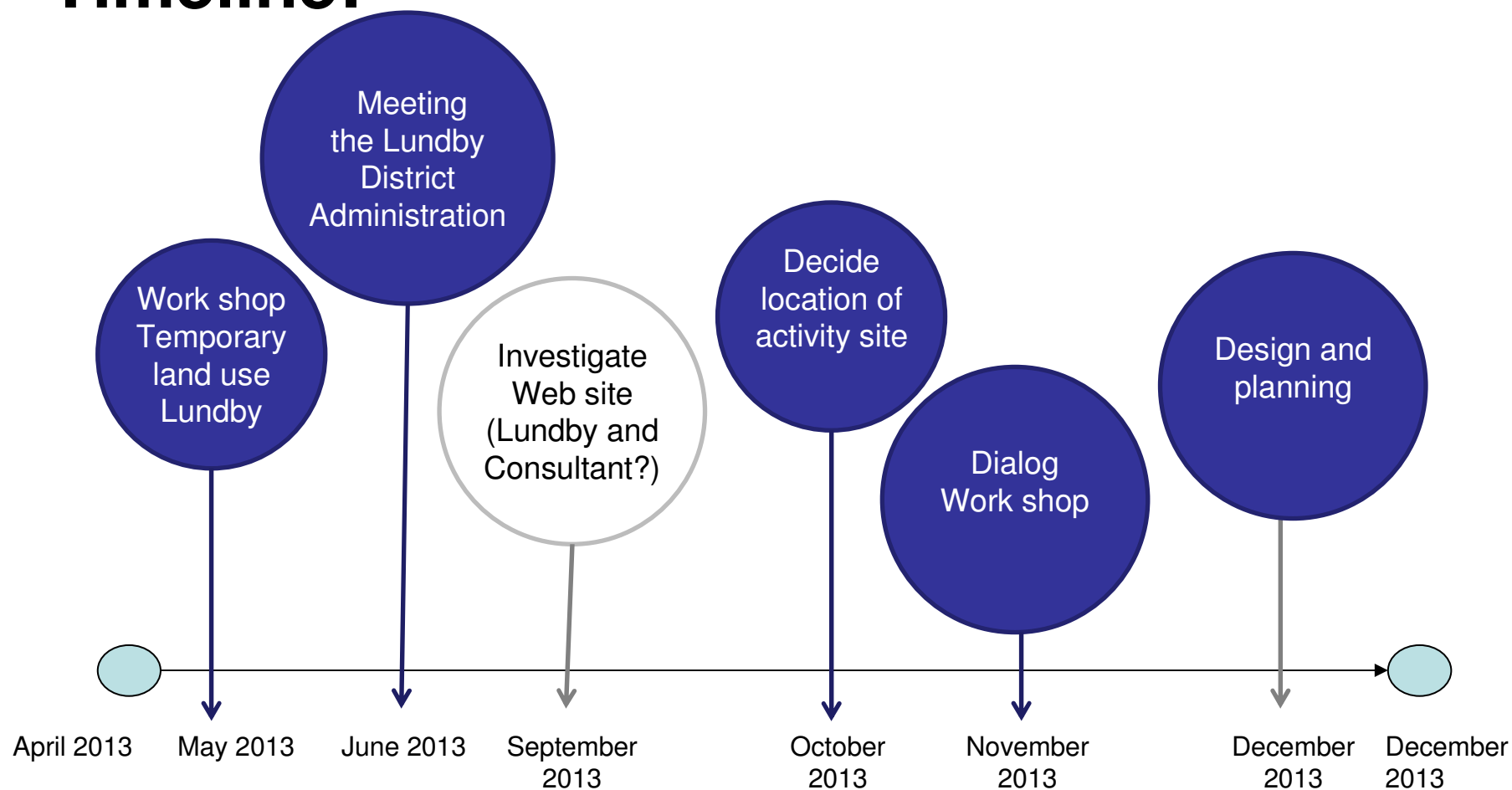

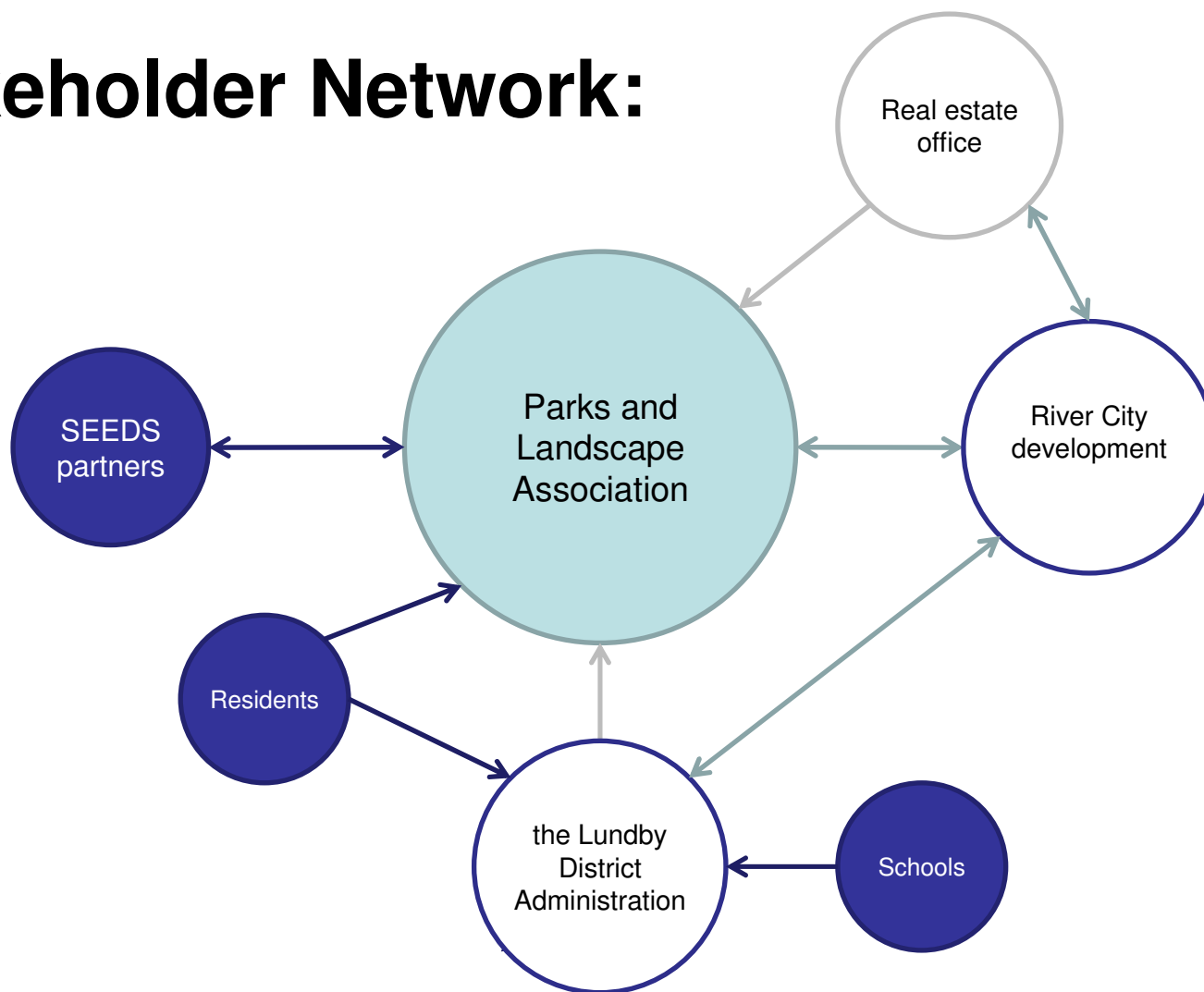

Solutions:

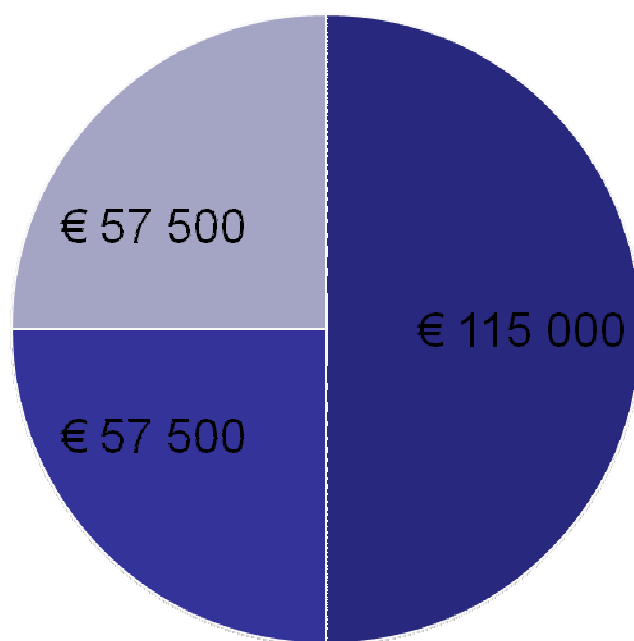
- Dialogue with the Real Estate Office
