Stakeholder Network: placekeeping phase

Management (Technical) Committee:
-Flemish administration: AMT: president
-VLM: secretary
-Members: ANB, vzw Nature point,
Harbour authority, Oostkustpolder
(= farmers representators organisation)

Engagement:

Farmers, who are doing the place keeping, have a contract with the harbour authorities



Policy: our challenges

Conflicting interests between management of the area as part of natura 2000 and future use for harbour purposes

Management in order to attain favourable state of conservation



The less (more) favourable the state of conservation, the less (more) the compensatory load in the future



Finance:

Farmers pay a fee to the harbour authority (owner) for the use of the land (even when there are lot of restrictions).

Practice:

Farmers are using the land with restrictions. Waterlevels in the area are monitored during the winter period.

Technical committee meets in March where thy will discuss the place keeping
