13 Regions from six North Sea countries cooperate in a project called Vital Rural Area, a European Cooperation Project, running from 2009-2014, co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund ERDF (Interreg IVB North Sea Region Programme)

The main goal of the project is directed towards the reinforcement and empowerment of rural areas, focussing on three main themes, the so called work packages (WP):

- 1) empowerment of small and medium-sized enterprises towards new economical prospects and innovations
- 2) branding of the region, towards a professional exposure of regions
- 3) optimizing services, towards more and better accessible services and amenities

All case studies performed start with an analysis of the region according to a specifically developed methodology. Together with an EU broad 'best practices' literature study in the three work package themes by a scientific team consisting of experts from different Universities, the development of a general working method for sustainable regional development, called the Rural Power Pack, is built. This Rural Power Pack, that is to be delivered in 2013, forms the basis for the dissemination and practical use throughout the EU by finding transferable strategies to fortify and empower rural regions. Ultimately the RPP consists of an interactive box, containing practical instruments (a toolbox), a large number of innovative best practice cases from the three WP-themes and a working method to deal with specific regional policy issues.

To enable a sustainable implementation of the project cases the Co-operative Agreement Approach (CAA) is developed.
