

#### Waterways for Growth

- A framework for the sustainable development of inland waterways,
- New and expanded businesses based on waterways,
- A common approach to regenerate historic waterways,
- Extension of the network of recreational waterways,
- New approaches to further develop the sustainable development of waterways.





## **Financing Priority 4 Projects**

#### **Build with Care**

- Develop a transnational approach that encourages stakeholders to share practice and understanding, leading to e.g. improvements in accepted construction standards,
- Introduce alternative energy schemes for business and domestic users,
- Develop common energy standards for building and construction activities.
