### 1. What is Strategic Environmental Assessment?

SEA Directive 2001/42/EC

- Mainstreaming environmental policy (Art. 6 of EC Treaty)
- Plans and programmes, incl. Interreg-funded ones (see §1 SEA Directive)





# 2. Requirements for project (Lead) partners

- Check need for SEA!
- Refer to SEA Directive! and observe also national rules
- if SEA is required,
  - consider SEA procedure as part of the project implementation in the project design (Application Form)
- SEA provisions made by the projects will be considered by SC for decision-making





### 3. SEA in the application process

- With the application you confirm that the project as submitted complies with the SEA directive
- Application Form: Indicate environmental objectives relevant for your project in Application Form
- Application Form: Set up relevant indicators for monitoring of environmental effects of your project
