Transnational Co-operation in theory

Working between different levels of institutions/organisations,

- embracing different sectors,
- across national boundaries,
- in a large territory,

developing, preparing and implementing <u>shared solutions and joint</u> <u>infrastructures</u>,

which would otherwise not be achievable.

Ultimately developing and implementing shared solutions among/within regions:

- joint planning,
- joint implementation,
- joint investments,
- joint long term activities.






