Development of public space is not always successful over time

How could this happen?

- Lack of money (public and private)
- Lack of identification
- No level-playing field (chain-stores vs. small retailers)



What is the solution?

An public-private partnership to improve the district (a BID)

Definition:

A business improvement district (BID) is a public-private partnership (PPP) in which businesses in a defined area elect to pay an additional tax in order to fund improvements to the district's public realm and trading environment.

What's the project about?

- Use PPP in BID-form to invest in sustainable, attractive (viable) and competitive areas
- Involvement of everybody in a district to create an win-win situation
